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TRAINING PROGRAMS AT THE HAVEN

Studies at The Haven Institute are designed to suit a broad range of life circumstances, interests, and learning styles. Individuals can experience the pleasure of personal discovery and professional development in an atmosphere respectful of their particular strengths and challenges. Our training focuses on learning how to

- Support others while being fully present with ourselves
- Work in an interdependent team, being personal and supportive
- Develop skills in interpersonal communication, energetic experiential forms and group facilitation

1 Certificate Prerequisites

Completion of these is required for admission to the Certificate training program.

2 Certificate in Haven Counselling Skills (CertHCS)

Upon completion of the Certificate Prerequisites, the student may apply for admission to the Certificate training program by submitting an application form to the Registrar and requesting an interview with the Director of Intern Training. A \$150 registration fee is payable.

Students accepted into the Certificate training program participate in required and elective programs. Internship can begin after completion of Living Alive Phase II as a participant and involves working with leaders to plan and run the group while holding the needs of the participants as primary. Graduation from this training program requires not only the completion of specified programs and electives, but also a demonstrated ability to work in a team setting and to act in an ethical manner with fellow students, participants and Haven staff and faculty.

3 The Diploma Training Programs

Completion of the Certificate in Haven Counselling Skills is a requirement before applying for admission to one of the Diploma training programs. The student fills out an application form, and is interviewed by the Director of Intern Training. A \$150 registration fee is payable.

Students pursuing either Diploma will, with the guidance of the Director of Intern Training, intern and participate in a series of programs, prepare papers, and take on increasing responsibility in the running of portions of programs and working with participants.

The student is awarded a Haven Diploma upon successful completion of the required programs and credits for the specific training program *and* upon demonstration of high levels of interpersonal skills, sound judgment, and skill in using energetic experiential forms in a responsible and ethical way.

Diploma in Haven Counselling Skills (DipHCS)

Study in this path is intended for those whose career goals include work with individuals in various counselling settings or who wish to continue to explore their own personal growth.

Diploma in Haven Group Facilitation (DipHGF)

Study in this path is intended for those whose career goals include work in settings where group facilitation is prominent or who wish to continue to explore their own personal growth.

Second Diplomas

Those individuals who hold one Haven Diploma may obtain the second Diploma by:

- acquiring an additional 4 credits
- meeting all the requirements of the second Diploma.
